B. Admission into Accelerated Courses:

*****Mathematics 9** - Incoming Grade 8 students may be granted admission into Mathematics 9 using a combination of the following criteria:

1. Earning an A (86% or greater) on the Grade 8 Mathematics Challenge Exam
2. Recommendation of Grade 7 mathematics teacher

Sr. Level French - Incoming Grade 8 students coming from French Immersion programs will be granted admission into a Sr. Level French course using a combination of the following criteria:

1. Recommendation of Grade 7 French Immersion teacher
2. Grade 8 French Challenge Exam Final Mark

C. Select either 1 of the following Elective Courses:
